Professional accreditations Malta Festival Poznan have been created for representatives of Polish and European theatres, theatre groups, theatre festivals as well as theatre school and theatrology students.

Sales regulations for professional accreditations at Malta Festival Poznań 2017:

- 1. Accreditations are sold by Malta Foundation at Ratajczaka 44, 61-278 Poznań (Poland), hereinafter referred to as the "Organizer".
- 2. Sales are limited by the number of available accreditations. Orders will be accepted until supplies last.
- 3. Holders of the professional accreditation are entitled to:
 - enter 5 plays chosen from the programme table attached to the regulations (attachment 1),
 - 20% discount on book publications by Organizer,
 - receive the festival magazine and T-shirt by Organizer,
 - reservation free of charge passes for performances by Organizer. Due to the limited pool of free tickets to events, not all the terms may be available
 - to receive a voucher for Nextbike city bikes worth PLN 20 for use during the festival

After 5 plays have been chosen from the list, a festival guide assigned by the Organizer will put together an individual path/plan for the accredited person to make it easier to attend all selected performances.

In case of failing to attend the chosen performance, the Organizer has no obligation to refund any costs or make a reservation for a different show time or a different play. The accreditation is a form of the ticket and its holder is bound by the event regulations applicable to the festival audience.

- 4. The holder of the accreditation has a reservation for only one seat at a given theatre spectacle for the show time specified in the accreditation.
- 5. One person can order only one accreditation for a given person. It is allowed to order the accreditation for a third person. One person can order more than one accreditation (for different people).
- 6. The accreditation cannot be transferred to another person.
- 7. The accreditation cannot be returned.
- 8. No duplicates of the accreditation will be issued.

- 9. The price of the professional accreditation is 60,00 PLN (inc. VAT). It is on sale from May 16th, 2017 until supplies last, but no longer than by June 6th, 2017.
- 10. The total for the accreditation order should be transferred to the Organizer's account within 24 hours after receiving the confirmation of the accreditation. Transfers made before receiving the Organizer's confirmation will be returned to the payer's account.
- 11. Granting the accreditation will be confirmed by email within 14 days of registering the transfer on the Organizer's bank account. We do not accept transfers by Poczta Polska (Polish Post).
- 12. Unpaid orders will not be processed.
- 13. The accreditation can be collected only by the person to whom it was issued. It can be collected upon showing proof of identity at the festival office at Wolności Square in Poznań from the first day of the Malta Festival Poznan, at June 16^{th,} 2017 between 10.00-21.00.
- 14. The Organizer reserves the right to stop the distribution of the accreditations at any time without notice.
- 15. In matters not regulated by these rules to the regulations of the organizer available on malta-festival.pl
- 16. Personal information provided to the administrator will be used solely for handling accreditations.
- 17. The buyer's personal information will not be handed over to third parties without his knowledge and permission. Making the transfer to the Organizer's bank account is equivalent to accepting the content of this regulation and providing the Organizer with personal information. By purchasing the accreditation on behalf of a third person you confirm that you have the authorization of this person to make all the declarations included in this regulation.
- 18. Everyone has the right to inspect and correct their personal information.
- 19. The Organizer reserves the right to make changes to terms and conditions in this regulation as well as cancelling particular events during the Festival without stating reasons.
